## To make a basic jello-salad-in-a-serving-bowl:

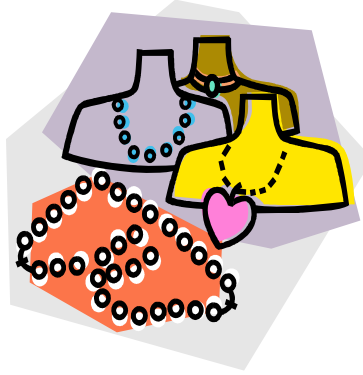
